Advanced Marine Navigation


(aka Advanced Piloting) 10 –12 week course



- Review of skills learned in Marine Navigation (currently offered as Piloting)
- Advanced positioning techniques such as advancing a line of position
- Other electronics: radar, depth sounders, autopilots, laptop software, etc.
- Hazard avoidance techniques using electronics (e.g., "keep out" zones in GPS)
- Collision avoidance using radar and GPS
- Working with tides: clearances, depth, effects of current
- Piloting with wind and currents
- The "Seaman's Eye" simple skills for checking that one is on course

Advanced Marine Navigation (aka Advanced Piloting) is the 2nd in the sequence of USPS courses on navigation. It continues to build coastal and inland navigation skill, allowing the student to take on more challenging conditions – unfamiliar waters, limited visibility, and extended cruises.

As in with Marine Navigation (aka *Piloting*), the course includes many in-class exercises, helping students advance their skills through hands-on, guided practice sessions.
